JOB SUMMARY:

Performs janitorial and maintenance tasks related to the safe and efficient operation of the Recreation Complex including ice surface maintenance.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Provides information to the public and facility; ensures proper use of facilities and equipment.
- Operates, maintains and repairs ice making plant involving ammonia and chiller systems.
- Prepares, paints and maintains ice surfaces using an ice resurfacer and power ice edger.
- Ensures that proper emergency shut-down procedures are followed and directs the public in the event of a building evacuation; provides assistance to recreation users when injured.
- Ensures all doors are properly locked at closing time to safeguard equipment and facility security.
- Performs janitorial functions such as cleaning washrooms, floors, and doors and windows.
- Collects and removes garbage and recycling from inside the Recreation Complex.
- Replenishes adequate cleaning supplies and dispenser articles.
- Sets up and takes down tables, chairs and related equipment for program and special events.
- Performs building maintenance including plumbing, light electrical and carpentry repairs.
- Attends crew safety talks and required safety training; follows safe work procedures; reports hazards, injuries and near misses.
- Operates cleaning and maintenance equipment and small hand and power tools.
- Performs light maintenance on equipment; keeps maintenance records.
- Maintains professional and technical requirements for the position.
- Performs related duties as required.

LICENSES OR SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS:

- Valid B.C. Class 5 Driver's License
- Refrigeration Operator Certificate or better
- Arena Icemaker Certificate (would be an asset)
- W.H.M.I.S. Certificate (can be taken upon hiring)

REQUIRED EXPERIENCE:

- Shall have a minimum 90 days experience in ice making and building maintenance.
- Or an equivalent combination of experience and education.

PAY RATE:

This is a seasonal, union position with a pay rate of \$25.49 per hour (2014). Candidates that do not meet these requirements may be considered for this position and classified at the Icemaker 1 or 2 pay level.
