

PART TIME SKATE PATROL/INSTRUCTOR

The Strathcona Regional District has openings for Part Time Skate Patrol Attendants – we need staff available on a call-in basis on weekends, evenings, and daytime shifts.

The Skate Patrol/Instructor is responsible for providing safe skating sessions to the public by keeping patrons informed on the rules/policies that ensure a fun & safe skating experience. Other responsibilities include distributing and sharpening skates, assisting patrons with equipment or skating difficulties and answering questions, administering first aid, teaching skating, hockey and private lessons, assisting with special events, checking for receipt of payment and maintaining records, and general housekeeping for public skating areas and the skate-shop.

Candidates must be available to work a variety of shifts, including days, evenings and weekends on an on-call basis. Hours are determined by program registrations and special events.

Requirements:

- Completion of Grade 10
- Must be at least 16 years of age
- Previous hockey or figure skating experience
- Previous experience working with children in a leadership capacity
- Current Standard First Aid and CPR "C" Certificate
- Super host is desirable

The rate of pay for this position is in accordance with the United Steel Workers, Local 1-1937 collective agreement.

The successful candidates will be required to undergo and pass a criminal record check.
