Public Works Labourer

Regular Part Time

The Village of Zeballos is looking for an enthusiastic, hard working individual to perform general labour, basic maintenance, construction and emergency work. This work will involve operating small equipment and trucks, while following operational and safety procedures.

Responsibilities

This is routine manual work entailing considerable physical effort and agility in the safe performance of a variety of unskilled and semi-skilled jobs such as maintenance and construction of roads, pavement, sewers, utilities and parks. The Labourer will operate a variety of small equipment while performing tasks such as grass cutting, installing signs, compacting materials, cutting pipe and litter collection. Garbage pickup and landfill duties on Wednesdays and Saturdays is part of this position. This position also assists with emergency maintenance and repairs as required.

Requirements

This is a part time position with up to 30 hours per week to start as soon as possible and continue until approximately mid October when the hours may vary depending on operation requirements. Weekend work is required.
