Key Responsibilities:


- Optimize the open pit mine planning and mine designs to improve ore extraction and balance waste stripping ratio with long-term mine planning requirements;
- Responsible for collating and making sense of field data to support inputs required for operational mine planning and scheduling;
- Responsible for the development of short-range mine planning & scheduling operational packages;
- Actively support development and implementation of projects across areas of the mining engineering function;
- Assist with the optimization of the short-range scheduling and design, through application of sound engineering design scheduling methods;
- Proactively support mine engineering to solve problems through development of mine plans and schedules;
- Conduct project planning, producing project schedules, analyzing project progress and reporting on the project planning indicators;


Who we are:


