West Coast Aquatic (WCA) and the Nootka Sound Watershed Society (NSWS) are seeking submissions from interested individuals for a Nootka Sound Fisheries Stewardship Coordinator.

Location:	Nootka Sound Region (Tahsis, Zeballos, Gold River, Kyuquot, Mowachaht/ Muchalaht)
Background:	WCA is managing a program under the Pacific Integrated Commercial Fisheries Initiative (PICFI) for the purposes of facilitating collaborative management of West Coast of Vancouver Island fisheries. To support this management, NSWS has conducted a Risk Assessment that identifies priority actions needed to enhance and/or restore fish habitat in the Nootka region. The purpose of this contract position is to help advance and coordinate associated stewardship projects led by NSWS.
Contract Activities:	 Project related proposal writing and fundraising Coordinating and managing field based projects and related personnel Ensuring all funding requirements are met (e.g. deliverables, timelines, budgets, reporting) Ensuring all project related legal requirements are met (e.g. insurance, safety) Liaising between NSWS, other project contractors and government External communications (e.g. raising the profile of Society activities, attracting new volunteers)
Contract Goals:	 Raise a minimum of \$0.30 of project related cash, in-kind or other resources for every contract dollar received Generate additional funds to financially self-sustain the position beyond the 2015/16 fiscal year
Skills and Assets:	 Knowledge of the Nootka Sound area Ability to work well with First Nations, sport and commercial fishers, government representatives and other sectors Contacts and connections with local businesses, volunteers, schools and others Self-starter and strong time management Highly organized with an attention for detail Excellent written and oral communication Budgeting and project management Fisheries specific knowledge an asset but not necessary
