## **KBC** Community Health Nurse: Job Posting

Kwakiutl Band Council (KBC) is seeking a part-time (0.8 FTE) Community Health Nurse (aka Public Health Nurse) to work at the Health Centre in Fort Rupert – just outside of Port Hardy, BC. Salary to commensurate with experience. The Community Health Nurse's (CHN) position focuses on preventative health strategies to promote the health and well-being of individuals, the family and community by: assessing development, health, wellness, financial and social status, and determining risk factors; providing counseling, evaluation, health & wellness education and follow-up; promoting communicable disease control in the general population; developing partnerships to provide professional collaboration and consultation; assisting in the development of policies and action plans in the community; and acting as a health & wellness advocate.

It is paramount that all positions within the health team strive to communicate and serve the Kwakiutl people in a manner that respects, enhances and promotes the cultural identity and well-being of both the individual and the health care providers. Applicants are encouraged to review the job description for more details on this.

Applicants must have a Baccalaureate Degree in Nursing with current registration (RN) as a member in good standing with the Registered Nurses Association of British Columbia (RNABC). Applicants are strongly encouraged to review the job description prior to applying.
