Working with the Mental Health & Addictions team, the Clinical Counsellor provides direct patient support to Kwakiutl District Council member nation citizens. A well established trust within KDC communities and with KDC health clients is vital to the success of this position. The Clinical Counsellor is a permanent role and scheduled work is for a 7 hour day, 4 days per week, allowing for a reasonable work/life balance.

Reporting to the Mental Health & Addictions Program Manager, the Clinical Counsellor is a professionally-accredited position and key role is to provide counseling to individuals, families and youth, across all KDC Health sites. The position applies knowledge and experience in providing therapy for a range of individual and family situations. The duties of this position include providing counseling services to an active caseload of individuals, youth and families, coordinating therapy with other service providers, and participating as part of the KDC Health team to create and follow through on care plans for children and families.

A Masters degree in an allied health discipline including supervised practicum for an approved post-secondary institution, coupled with a minimum five (5) years directly-related experience as a Clinical Counsellor with minimum of one (1) year in a community setting, registered member in good standing with the BC Association of Clinical Counsellors or BC College of Psychologists and familiarity with clinical supervision and generally accepted practices required. Previous experience working in a First Nations Community setting is preferred.

In circumstances where there is an equal combination of qualifications and experience, preference will be given to people of Aboriginal heritage.
